



Annual Financial Report 2021

As of the 2nd August LSU Media's account stands at **£759.06**. Significantly lower than last academic year although this was expected considering there was no dance competition and we have half the number of members as last year due to the coronavirus pandemic.

This year we reduced the cost of membership to reflect the pandemic to £25 and LSU Media has received £2,089.94. LSU Media collected one payment from members for Stash which equalled £716.56.

LSU Media has earned £224.20 as a result of Commercial Equipment and Staffing bookings, all of which was obtained through a project for Enterprise.

This year, LSU Media spent £847.80 on Radio Licenses and National Affiliations, included in this was £322.00 to have the rights to share live news on LCR.

LSU Media received another £400 fine as a result of historical copyright this year. This has been paid in full by the Union and has not come out of our accounts.

LSU Media's total income for this year stands at £3,108.48, down from £9,661.67 in the last academic year.
